Other notes regarding show entries:

1. Group classes, Junior Owned & Showmanship entries will be accepted at the show.
2. Substitutions must be received by Nov 3, 2010. Substitutions must be an animal of the same sex and must share the same birth month
3. Exhibitors/owners must be active, associate or junior members of the ELAA or will not be allowed to compete in the show.
5. All bulls, 15 months old or older on show day, must have proof of a satisfactory semen test, performed by a licensed Veterinarian, within 90 days of the show.
6. All females 20 months of age or older must be confirmed pregnant within 90 days of the show or have a natural calf at their side.
7. Only natural born 2010 calves that are nursing their dam, will be allowed to compete in the cow/calf classes.
8. All cattle and stall areas must be presented in a professional attractive manner.
